The road to Casa de la Mina

Work will start on this road during the last week in September. 86,982.69 euros has been allocated by the Diputación Provincial to the company "Jimenez Colmenar" for the major works programme, for example concreting parts of the road etc. The part of the road starts at the "Venta de Palma" up to the entrance of the "Cruz del Monte" a total of 1 km. and 52 mts.

Tracks in the Campo:

The Town Hall is continuing with the improvement to the network of tracks in the campo.

Nursery.

The new term has started at the nursery "Matrona Angeles Cabra" with a total of 51 children. The team working at the Nursery comprises. 4 monitors, 1 cook, and 1 cleaner.

Extension of the Museum of Arts and Customs.

Work begins on Monday the 3rd of October on the extension to the Museum of Arts and Customs. The cost of the extensión is 60,000 euros and is financed by the PFEA, work is due to be completed by the 30th of December 2011.

This will provide an additional auditorium below the existing auditorium on the ground floor.

NATURAL PARK SIERRAS TEJEDA, ALMIJARA Y ALHAMA.

Lobularia marítima (L.)

Common name: Sea Alyssum

Family: Brassicaceae.

Habitat: Grazed fields, beaches and other sandy areas, rocky places and often as a weed in gardens.

Ecology: Abundant coastal to hills, Southern Europe and North Africa.

Description: Small perennial herb with a thick tuberous root descending deeply. Leaves small from rather dark green to silver with silky hairs. Flowers about 5mm across, or less, petals separate, rounded, white occasionally flushed with pink, sweet scented. Two seeds in a capsule, one in each envelope (loculus)

Traditional Uses: Used as an ornamental plant in parks and gardens. The leaves and young stalks are sometimes used in salads and other such dishes.
