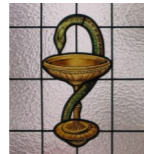
State Subsidised Housing.

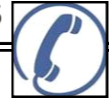

SAN BLAS

Friday 3rd February
San Blas was a Bishop, he was martyred in the year 316. Working as a doctor in Sebaste, (Armenia) he distinguished himself by curing the sick, his specialism was in diseases of the throat. Traditionally Cómpeeta celebrates San Blas with the blessing of the "roscas de pan". These bread rings are taken to the church where the priest blesses them and ties a ribbon on to the ring. The bread is eaten and the ribbon is worn around the neck to ward off sore throats. The day starts with local schoolchildren, followed by adults. You are all invited.

FERIA - SAN SEBASTIAN 2012



This weekend we celebrate the fiesta of the patrón saint of Cómpeeta, San Sebastian. He was born in Narbona (256–258) and was martyred in the third century. San Sebastian was a military man, an officer in the Praetorian Guard in Rome. Pope Cayo awarded him the prestigious title of "Defender of the Church" for his sympathy towards the christians.

Denounced as a christian he was shot with lots of arrows and left for dead, but a friendly christian nursed him back to health only to be beaten and whipped to death. A popular saint he was praised for his help with the plague. The origins of the fiesta date back to the expulsión of the Moors and the resurgence of Christianity.

FICHA VII

Capparis spinosa L.
Common name: Caper
Family: Capparaceae

Location: May be found in all of the coastal provinces, it is abundant in the arid zones of the East and in particular in Andalucía.

Ecology: Grows wild in the rock crevices and cracks in walls. Prefers the mild warm climate of the coastal zones but can be found at 900 to 1000 metres.

Description: Capers have long been used in the Mediterranean for scurvy and rheumatism. This shrub has small heart shaped flower buds which are harvested as the caper. The pink and white flowers have an extremely short life. They open in the early morning and are dead by midday. They must be picked by hand while they are in bud. On the same day they are pickled in brine where they remain for two months. However the characteristic sharp taste develops only when the capers are put in wine vinegar afterwards.

Traditional uses: To bring piquancy and tartness to sauces.

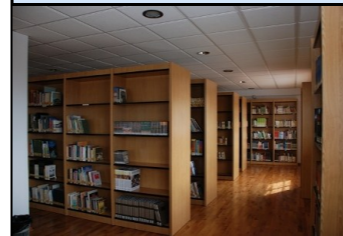
COURSES

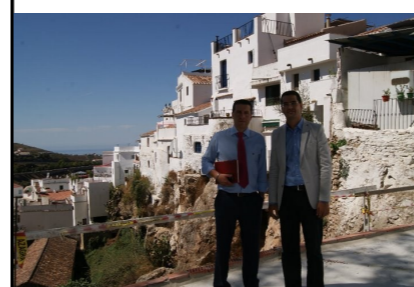
Water Rates - Junta de Andalucía

The Law 9/2010 of the 30th July, concerning water rates for Andalucía, established a rate for all those houses supplied with domestic water. In the situation where the number of people living in the same house is more than four, they will pay less. As a result we urge you to present, whatever payed up bills you may have, for houses with five or more people, to the “Department of Reclamation” at the Town Hall. The application will start the process which has to be renewed every two years.
